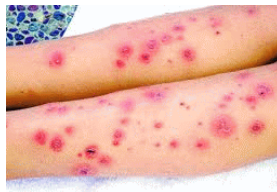

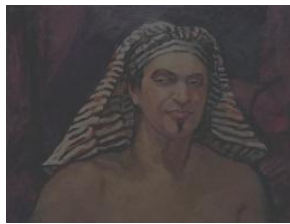

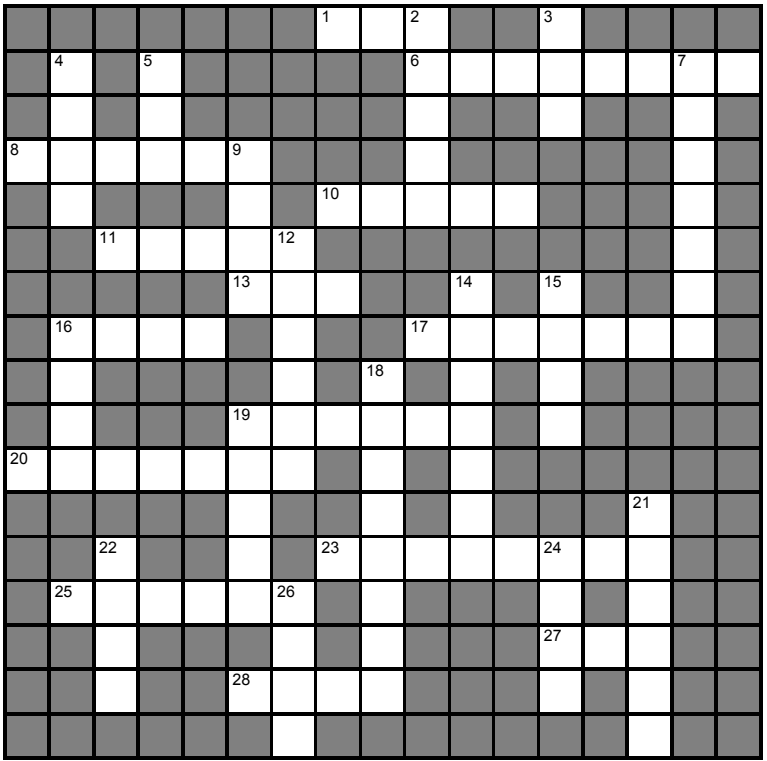

# The Password

Do you remember your password?  
You say “Which one?”

When we visit a certain website we need to remember our password. Generally we are the person that made up our password so we can remember it. Sometimes we forget, so a lot of sites say, “Did you forget your password? If so, click here.

There are times when a person may need a password to enter a building. Perhaps in the military you will not gain access until your password has been verified.

This account of an American Civil War (1861-1865) preacher is taken from *The Children’s Hour* published in 1944.

The night was dark as the rider and his horse came near to the sentry’s post. “Halt! Who goes there?” The preacher replied “a Friend.” The sentry says “Approach, friend. Give me the password.”

As the rider came nearer, he dismounted and soon came face to face with the sentry, who had his gun pointed directly at the preacher’s heart.

The preacher had visited many outpost camps. He was faithful in presenting the Gospel (The Good News) of the love of God the Father sending His only begotten Son into this sin-filled Earth. He presented from the Bible (the Word of God) the account of Jesus being the eternal Son of God, the only one worthy to take upon Himself the sin of mankind that separated man from God.

The preacher, as he stood with the sentry’s gun pointed at him, gave the password: “Lincoln.”

There was then a deadly silence as the two men faced each other. “That’s not the password. “Don’t you hate that when that happens to you? Its like when you can’t remember the combination to your lock on your locker in school.”

Since it was a time of war, the sentry could have been justified in shooting or capturing the preacher. The sentry said “I know you, you would pay the penalty of your mistake with your life. At the risk of my own life I spare yours. Go back and get the correct password.”

The preacher thanked the sentry for his kindness mounted his horse and rode back to the last post. There he found that the password had been changed to “Massachusetts” (anyone reading this from Cambridge or Spingfield?).

Riding back, the preacher gave the correct password to the sentry. The sentry replied “Pass on and all’s well.”

The preacher talked for a few moments saying “At the risk of your own life you have spared mine.” “Let me ask you, do you have the right password for Heaven? The sentry replied ‘Yes Sir!’ I have.”

What is the correct password for Heaven? The reply from the sentry was “Jesus.” The preacher asked. “Where did you learn that?”

The answer surprised the preacher. This man said when I was younger I attended the Sunday School in Pennsylvania where the preacher taught (lots of assemblies in PA: anybody from there reading this?).
